The successful candidate will provide leadership and mentoring to other camp staff, campers, and volunteers, while maintaining a safe and enjoyable environment. Our Senior Environmental Educators are responsible for upholding the policies and procedures of the FAB Nature Camps and the FAB Mission and are responsible for the daily operations of the site.
