This week, we'll explore the fascinating world of turtles, why their populations are declining, and how you can be part of the solution to help protect these incredible creatures. Turtles belong to the same class of animals (Reptilia) as snakes and lizards, which might explain why they all seem to have a hard time staying in their seats!
